Pandora also searches for the path of life. She is not afraid, she suffers but curiosity does not let her stop looking and observing.




Pandora opens the box and winds come out scattering all over the world.

Desolate she follows the trail they have left.


Bit by bit she takes hope from each one of the winds and she keeps the little secret of life.




Pandora can now get the box without any problem. She begins to open it little by little with curiosity and the emotion of not knowing what there is inside it.






We see the lights again and hear the sounds from the beginnings but from the opposite side of the stage. Pandora observes and sees how the vigilant encircles her until she has no escape.
